


ACAMPA-TEEN










TOUR TO NORTHERN AND CENTRAL BRAZIL

BELÉM - PA










On July 31st, I left for the city of Belém, where I stayed until August 6th. During these days, we had several training sessions with the church and song leaders. The Crispim family hosted and took care of me the entire time I was in the city, even looking after me when I arrived with a severe ear infection, the result of taking the flight from Manaus to Belém while still recovering from a cold. I had to start antibiotic treatment during my stay in Belém, but it was a very fruitful visit, and some young people there are considering studying at ARCA next year.
